

# **GWENNAP PARISH COUNCIL**



The regular Meeting of the Parish Council Minutes held on Monday 10th November 2025 at 7.00 pm In attendance: Cllr Richard Williams {Chair} (RW), Cllr Greg Foxwell {Vice Chair}, Cllr Andi Freeman, Cllr Steve Trelease {ST}, Cllr Julian Hughes {JH}, Cllr Jemma Moses (JM). Chris Ring Parish Clerk (PC) Members of the public were in attendance

- 1. Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Veryan Pascoe-Edward
- 2. Declarations of interest: There were none

## 3. Public Session:

Members of the public raised the issues of parking at Trelawney Estate, possible unlawful trading and overcrowding. The PC will write to Cornwall Housing to discuss the issues raised.

A question was also asked about the Affordable Housing projects. RW advised any persons interested in the accommodation available to register with Homechoice.

A resident raised the issues of overgrown hedges on a path in Crofthandy. The PC advised residents to report such issues to Cornwall Council and to inform the PC of these reports.

The applicant of planning application PA25/07681 explained the reasons for their application and answered questions from Councillors.

- 4. To receive the monthly report from Cornwall Councillor John Thomas MBE: Cllr Thomas sent his apologies and he will send a written report to the Clerk. This will be included within the published minutes.
- 5. It was RESOLVED that the minutes of the Parish Council meeting of 20th October 2025 be approved as a correct record. The Chair signed the approved minutes of that meeting.

### 6. Correspondence:

RW had received an email from a resident regarding a potential planning violation near Sunny Corner. RW advised that they report this to Cornwall Council and Cllr John Thomas.

- 7. Neighbourhood Priorities Statement (NPS) Update:
- RW will be meeting a consultant next week to discuss assisting with the drafting of the NDP. The working group will meet on 1 December 2025
- 8. Affordable Housing Update: There have been no significant developments since the last meeting.
- 9. Highways and public rights of way:

The PC reported he was waiting for quotes for the works needed on the bus shelter in Crofthandy.

#### 10. Wheal Maid:

RW reported that Mei Loci were due to complete the Feasibility Study soon and it was hoped to convene a full public consultation at Crofthandy Village Hall early in the new year.

- 11. Cemetery: It was RESOLVED to purchase a compost bin for the cemetery for the disposal of flowers.
- 12. Parish rooms and Playing Field:
- 12.1 The Agreement with Frogpool and Cusgarne Football club has now been agreed and awaits signing.
- 12.2 To discuss a request from the football club re the installation of Dugouts. It was RESOLVED that the dugouts as proposed not be approved.

## 13. FINANCE:

- 13.1 It was RESOLVED that the payments set out at Appendix 1, be approved.
- 13.2 It was RESOLVED that the Bank Reconciliations as checked by RW and GF and set out at Appendix 2, be accepted.
- 13.3 The PC discussed the budget and Precept. It was RESOLVED that the budget be approved and it was RESOLVED to set the precept at £63500, a 5% increase for band D properties. It was noted that the increase was necessary to cover inflation and the reduction in income under some budget headings.
